HOW IT WORKS

We are committed to limiting the quantity of espresso machine or grinder components that end up in the landfill. Once you deliver your machine to us, we will thoroughly assess it to determine if there are any reusable parts and then do our best to recycle any of the components (stainless steel, aluminum, brass, copper and some plastics) that cannot be re-used as parts.

We are continuously investigating new ways to break down, recycle and re-use the materials used in espresso machine and grinder construction, but we are unable to re-use them or recycle them 100%. However, the ultimate contribution to the landfill will be significantly less than what it would be if the machine was thrown away intact.

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO

While much of the machine will likely be recycled, we want to ensure that any reusable components are not damaged during transit. To limit the impact of shipping or delivery, we have a few suggestions on how to prepare your machine.

1. Drain Your Boiler:

Draining your boiler is essential -- freezing and leaking can damage boilers that are shipped or transported with water still in them. For step-by-step instructions on how to perform this on your type of machine, please visit:

2. Packaging Your Machine for Shipping:
