IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

Follow the basic safety precautions

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions shall always be followed, to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and/or injury to persons, including the following:

- Read all instructions.
- Do not touch hot surfaces. Use handles or knobs.
- To protect against fire, electric shock and injury to persons, do not immerse power cord, plugs, or body of machine in water or other liquid.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning.
 Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts, and before cleaning the appliance.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug or after the appliance malfunctions, or has been damaged in any manner. Return appliance to the nearest authorized service facility for examination, repair or adjustment.
- The use of an accessory attachment not recommended by the appliance manufacturer may result in fire, electric shock, or injury to persons.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let the cord hang over the edge of a table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.

Intended use

The appliance is designed and intended for household use only. It shall only be used for coffee preparation and to heat milk and water, according to these instructions. Use for any other purpose will be deemed improper. JURA Elektroapparate AG cannot accept any responsibility for the consequences of improper use.

People, including children, who

- do not have the physical, sensory or mental capabilities to use the appliance safely or
- are inexperienced or lack knowledge in how to use the appliance safely

must be supervised by a responsible person when using it, or must be instructed in how to use it correctly.

Special power cord set instructions

- A short power-supply cord is to be provided to reduce risks resulting from becoming entangled in or tripping over a longer cord.
- The cord shall be arranged so that it will not drape over the counter top or table top where it can be pulled on by children or tripped over.
- This appliance has a 3-pin grounded plug.
- Do not modify the plug in any way.

Extension cords are available an may be used if care is exercised in their use.

If the user chooses to use an extension cord,

- the marked electrical rating of the extension cord should be at least as great as the electrical rating of the appliance, and
- if the appliance is of the grounded type, the extension cord should be a grounding type 3-wire cord, and
- the longer cord should be arranged so that it will not drape over the counter top or tabletop where it can be pulled on by children or tripped over.

⚠ WARNING



To reduce the risk of fire or electric shock, DO NOT remove any service covers. DO NOT modify the appliance in any way that is not described in these instructions. NO user serviceable parts included. Repair MUST be done by authorized personnel only.

In the event of signs of damage, for example if there is a smell of burning, unplug the machine immediately from outlet and contact JURA customer service.

IMPORTANT SAFFGUARDS

⚠ CAUTION

Any servicing other than cleaning and user maintenance shall be performed by an authorized service representative:

- Do not immerse base in water or try to disassemble.
- Do not put the appliance or any individual parts in the dishwasher.
- Check voltage to be sure that the voltage indicated on the name plate complies with your voltage. The name plate is located on the underside of the appliance.
- Never use warm or hot water to fill the water container. Use cold water only.
- Keep your hands and the cord away from hot parts of the appliance during operation.

There is a risk of scalds or burns on the spouts and the hot water nozzle.

- Keep children away.
- Do not touch any hot parts. Use the handles or knobs provided.

NOTICE

- Never clean with scouring powders or hard implements.
- Ensure that the ventilation slots are not covered.
- Never pull out the drip tray during the brewing process. Only pull the drip tray when the display instructs you or when the appliance is ready for use.



NEVER DO (or you will void your warranty protection):

- Never fill instant coffee, chocolate mix etc. into the bean container or ground coffee funnel (filler funnel for ground coffee). It will damage the functioning of the brewing chamber.
- Never fill sugar coated coffee beans into the bean container. In case of doubt, call your dealer.
- Never fill anything other than coffee beans into the bean container (no chocolate, no rice, no nuts, no spices, nothing other than roasted coffee beans).
- Never fill frozen beans into the bean container. If you store beans in the freezer, let them thaw 3 to 4 hours before filling them into the bean container.

IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

- Never fill anything but fresh, cold and clean water into the water tank, except when decalcifying.
- Never use mineral or carbonated water. You can use tap water, bottled water, spring water and reverse osmosis water.
- Never do anything with the machine which is not described in these instructions. In case of doubt, call your dealer.

1 Preparing and using for the first time

Setting up the machine

When setting up your JURA, please note the following:

- Place the JURA on a horizontal surface that is not sensitive to water.
- Choose a spot for your JURA which protects the machine against overheating. Ensure that the ventilation slots are not covered.



Filling the bean container

NOTICE

Coffee beans which have been treated with additives (e.g. sugar), ground coffee or freeze-dried coffee will damage the grinder.

- Only use roasted, untreated coffee beans to fill the bean container.
 - ► Remove the aroma preservation cover.
 - Remove any dirt or foreign objects from inside the bean container.
 - Fill the bean container with coffee beans and close the aroma preservation cover.

Determining the water hardness

When you use the machine for the first time, you must set the water hardness. If you do not know the hardness of your water, you can find this out first. Use the Aquadur® test strips supplied with the machine.

- Hold the test strip briefly (for 1 second) under flowing water.
 Shake off the water.
- ► Wait for about 1 minute.



► You will then be able to read the degree of water hardness from the discoloration of the Aquadur® test strip and the description on the packaging.

First-time use



If the machine is operated with a defective power cord, there is a danger of potentially fatal electric shock.

- ► Never use a machine which is damaged.
- ▶ Never use a machine which has a defective power cord.
- i The water volume is given as standard in 'oz'. You can change this setting to 'ml' in programming mode (see Chapter 4 'Permanent settings in programming mode Unit for amount of water').

Precondition: The bean container has been filled.

- ▶ Insert the power plug into a power socket.
- ► Press the On/Off button 🖰 to switch the WE6 on.

'Choose language'

- i To display more languages, press the '>' button.
 - Press the button that corresponds to the language you want, e.g. 'English'.

'Saved' appears briefly on the display.

'Water hardness'

1 Preparing and using for the first time

- i If you do not know the hardness of your water, you must find this out first (see Chapter 1 'Preparing and using for the first time – Determining the water hardness').
 - ► Press the '<' or '>' button to change the setting for the water hardness.
 - ► Press the 'Save' button.
 - 'Saved' appears briefly on the display.
 - 'Filter operation'
 - ► Place a receptacle under the hot-water nozzle and under the coffee spout.
 - ▶ Remove the water tank and rinse it with cold water.



- ► Insert the CLEARYL Pro Smart filter cartridge into the water tank.
- ► Close the filter holder. It will click into place audibly.
- ► Fill the water tank with fresh, cold water and reinsert the tank.
- i The machine automatically detects that you have just inserted the filter cartridge.
 - 'Saved' appears briefly on the display.
 - 'Open switch'
 - ► Turn the switch to the ₫ position.
 - 'Filter is being rinsed', water flows out of the hot-water nozzle.
 - Rinsing of the filter stops automatically. 'Close switch' appears on the display.
 - ► Turn the switch to the ① position.
 - 'System is filling'
 - 'Empty drip tray'
 - ► Empty the drip tray and put it back into the machine.
 - 'Machine is rinsing'
 - The start screen is displayed. Your WE6 is ready for use.

Connect accessory (with wireless connection)

You have the option of connecting your WE6 wirelessly to a compatible accessory. To do this, the JURA Smart Connect must be plugged into the service socket.

- i The Smart Connect can be protected against unauthorized access using a PIN. Activate the PIN function via J.O.E.* your JURA app. You will find more information at
 - www.jura.com/smartconnect.
- i Please note that you can only connect either the accessory or J.O.E.* to the coffee machine via Smart Connect and not both at the same time.

Precondition: The start screen is displayed.

- ► Position the accessory near the coffee machine (a maximum of 0.5 m away).
- ► Switch on the accessory and the coffee machine.
- ► Press the reset button of the Smart Connect (e.g. with a paper clip).
- ► Then (within 30 sec.) press and hold the reset button of the accessory until the LED lights up to indicate the successful connection.

2 Preparation

⚠ WARNING

Hot coffee, hot steam and hot water can cause scalding. Scalding is a serious burn.

- ► Use extreme care when handling hot liquid or steam.
- Allow liquid to cool down before drinking.
- In the event of scalding, rinse affected area with cold water and seek medical attention.
- Keep children AWAY.
- i You can stop the machine at any time while a specialty coffee or hot water is being prepared. Just press any button (for a specialty coffee) or return the switch to its original position (for hot water).
- During the grinding operation you can select the coffee strength of single products by pressing the '<' and '>' buttons.
- i During preparation you can change the preset amount of water by pressing the '<' and '>' buttons.
- i The water volume is given as standard in 'oz'. You can change this setting to 'ml' in programming mode (see Chapter 4 'Permanent settings in programming mode Unit for amount of water').

Coffee tastes best served hot. A cold porcelain cup cools the beverage – and impairs the taste. We therefore recommend prewarming the cups. The full coffee aroma can develop only in prewarmed cups. You can purchase a JURA cup warmer from your specialized dealer.

You can make **permanent settings** for all products in programming mode (see Chapter 4 'Permanent settings in programming mode – Adjusting the product settings').

Espresso, coffee and other specialty coffees

Ristretto, espresso, coffee and special coffee are all prepared following this model.

Example: Proceed as follows to prepare one coffee.

Precondition: The start screen is displayed.

- ▶ Place a cup under the coffee spout.
- ► Press the 'Coffee' button.

Preparation starts. 'Coffee' and the coffee strength are displayed. The preset amount of water for coffee flows into the cup.

Preparation stops automatically. Your JURA is once more ready for use.

Two specialty coffees

To prepare **two** specialty coffees, press the appropriate preparation button twice (within approximately 1 second).

Example: Proceed as follows to prepare two espressi.

Precondition: The start screen is displayed.

- ► Place two cups under the coffee spout.
- ► Press the 'Espresso' button twice (within 1 second) to start preparation.

'2 espressi', the preset amount of water flows into the cups. Preparation stops automatically. Your JURA is once more ready for use.



Permanently setting the amount of water for the cup size

It is easy to permanently adjust the amount of water for all **single products** to the cup size. Adjust the amount once as shown in the following example. Every time you prepare a drink in the future, this amount will be dispensed.

Example: Proceed as follows to **permanently** set the amount of water for one coffee.

Precondition: The start screen is displayed.

- ▶ Place a cup under the coffee spout.
- ► Press and **hold** the 'Coffee' button until 'Enough coffee? Press button' appears.
- ► Release the 'Coffee' button.

 Preparation starts and the coffee flows into the cup.



2 Preparation

► Press any button except 'Cancel' as soon as there is sufficient coffee in the cup.

Preparation stops. 'Saved' appears briefly on the display. The set amount of water for one coffee is permanently stored. Your JURA is once more ready for use.

- i You can alter this setting at any time by repeating the above procedure.
- i You can also permanently set the amounts for all single products in programming mode (see Chapter 4 'Permanent settings in programming mode Adjusting the product settings').

Adjusting the grinder

You can adjust the grinder on a continuous scale to suit the degree of roast of your coffee.

NOTICE

If you adjust the consistency of grind when the grinder is not operating, the grinder adjustment wheel could be damaged.

 Only adjust the consistency of grind when the grinder is running.

The consistency of grind is correct if the coffee flows regularly from the coffee spout. In addition a fine, thick crema forms.

Example: Proceed as follows to change the consistency of grind **during** the preparation of an espresso.

- ▶ Place a cup under the coffee spout.
- ▶ Open the cover of the grinder adjustment switch.
- ► Press the 'Espresso' button to start preparation.
- ► Turn the grinder adjustment switch to the desired position while the grinder is running.

The preset amount of water flows into the cup. Preparation stops automatically.

► Close the cover of the grinder adjustment switch.



Hot water

△ CAUTION

There is a danger of scalding from hot water splashes.

Avoid direct contact with the skin.



Precondition: The start screen is displayed.

- ▶ Place a cup under the hot-water spout.
- ► Turn the switch to the ♠ position.

 'Hot water', the preset amount of water flows into the cup.

Preparation stops automatically. 'Switch close'

► Turn the switch to the ① position. Your JURA is once more ready for use.

3 Daily operation

3 Daily operation

Filling the water tank

Daily maintenance of the machine and hygiene when handling coffee and water are key to a perfect coffee result in the cup every time. You should therefore change the water **daily.**

NOTICE

Milk, sparkling mineral water or other liquids can damage the water tank or the machine.

- ► Only fill the water tank with fresh, cold water.
 - ► Open the water tank cover.
 - ► Remove the water tank and rinse it with cold water.
 - ► Fill the water tank with fresh, cold water and reinsert the tank
 - ► Close the water tank cover.



Switching on the machine



- ▶ Place a receptacle under the coffee spout.
- ▶ Press the On/Off button 🖰 to switch the JURA on.

'Welcome to JURA'

'Machine is rinsing', the system is rinsed. The rinse stops automatically. The start screen is displayed. Your JURA is ready for use.

Daily maintenance



To ensure that you get many years of reliable service out of your JURA and to guarantee the optimum coffee quality, the machine requires daily maintenance.

- ▶ Pull out the drip tray.
- ► Empty the coffee grounds container and the drip tray. Rinse them both with warm water.
- Always empty the coffee grounds container when the machine is switched on. This is the only way of resetting the coffee grounds counter.

- ► Refit the coffee grounds container and the drip tray.
- ▶ Rinse the water tank with clean water.
- ► Wipe the surface of the machine with a clean, soft, damp cloth (e.g. microfiber cloth).

Regular maintenance

Carry out the following maintenance actions **regularly** or **as required:**

- Clean the inside of the water tank, e.g. with a brush. Further information about the water tank is provided in these instructions for use (see Chapter 5 'Maintenance – Descaling the water tank').
- Traces of coffee may stick to the top and bottom of the cup platform. If this happens, clean the cup platform.

Switching off the machine

When the JURA is switched off, the system is automatically rinsed if a specialty coffee has been prepared.



- ▶ Place a receptacle under the coffee spout.
- ► Press the On/Off button 🖒.

'Machine is rinsing', the system rinses itself. The operation stops automatically. Your JURA is switched off.



4 Permanent settings in programming mode

⚠ WARNING

Hot coffee, hot steam and hot water can cause scalding. Scalding is a serious burn.

- ► Use extreme care when handling hot liquid or steam.
- ► Allow liquid to cool down before drinking.
- In the event of scalding, rinse affected area with cold water an seek medical attention.
- Keep children AWAY.

Press the 'P' button to enter programming mode. You can navigate through the program items and permanently save the required settings using the multi-function buttons. The following settings can be made:

Adjusting the product settings

⚠ WARNING

- Allow liquid to cool down before drinking.
- In the event of scalding, rinse affected area with cold water an seek medical attention.
- ► Keep children AWAY.

In the program item '3/5' / 'Expert mode' you can make individual settings for all specialty coffees and hot water. The following permanent settings can be made:

Permanent settings in programming mode always follow the same model.

Example: Proceed as follows to change the coffee strength for one coffee.

- ► Press the 'P' button.
- ► Press the '>' button several times until '3/5' is displayed.
- ► Press the 'Expert mode' button. 'Expert mode'
- i Next select the button of the product for which you would like to make settings. No product is prepared at this point.
- i To display more products, press the '>' button (bottom right).

4 Permanent settings in programming mode

- ► Press the 'Coffee' button.
 - 'Coffee'
- ► Press the 'Coffee strength' button.
 - 'Coffee' and the coffee strength is displayed.
- ► Press the '<' or '>' button to change the setting for the coffee strength.
- ► Press the 'Save' button.
 - 'Saved' appears briefly on the display.
 - 'Coffee'
- Press the 'L' button for around 2 seconds to exit programming mode.

Enable or disable setting of cup volume

In the program item '3/5' / 'Customise cup fill volume' you can make the following setting:

- "Active": The function 'Permanently setting the amount of water for the cup size' is activated. You can adjust the amount of water to the cup size by pressing and holding the relevant preparation button.
 - 'Inactive': The function 'Permanently setting the amount of water for the cup size' is deactivated. The amount of water cannot be adjusted to the cup size by pressing and holding the relevant preparation button.

Example: Proceed as follows to disable the function 'Permanently setting the amount of water for the cup size'.

- ► Press the 'P' button.
- ► Press the '>' button several times until '3/5' is displayed.
- ► Press the 'Customise cup fill volume' button.
 - 'Customise cup fill volume'
- ► Press the 'Inactive' button.
- ► Press the 'Save' button.
- 'Saved' appears briefly on the display.
- **'**3/5'
- ▶ Press the 'L' button to exit programming mode.

Enable or disable one-off settings

In the program item '3/5' / 'One-off settings' you can make the following setting:

- 'Active': One-off settings can be made during preparation (e.g. coffee strength or amount of water).
- 'Inactive': One-off settings cannot be made during preparation. The product is prepared according to the settings in programming mode ('3/5' / 'Expert mode').

Example: Proceed as follows to disable one-off settings during preparation.

- ► Press the 'P' button.
- ► Press the '>' button several times until '3/5' is displayed.
- ► Press the 'One-off settings' button.
 - 'One-off settings'
- ► Press the 'Inactive' button.
- Press the 'Save' button.'Saved' appears briefly on the display.'3/5'
- ► Press the 'L' button to exit programming mode.

Enable and disable products

In the program item '3/5' / 'Lock/enable' you can enable or disable each product individually.

Example: Proceed as follows to disable the preparation of hot water.

- ► Press the 'P' button.
- ► Press the '>' button several times until '3/5' is displayed.
- Press the 'Lock/enable' button. 'Lock/enable'
- i The lock symbol beside the product name indicates whether the product is enabled or disabled. If the lock is closed, the product is disabled.
 - Press the '>' button until the product 'Hot water' is displayed.
 - Press the 'Hot water' button.
 The lock is closed. Hot water preparation is now disabled.
 - Press the 'L' button for around 2 seconds to exit programming mode.

4 Permanent settings in programming mode

Automatic switch-off

By instructing your JURA to automatically switch itself off, you can cut down your energy consumption. If this function is activated, your JURA switches off automatically after the preset time following the last action on the machine.

You can set the automatic switch-off to 15 minutes, 30 minutes or 1–9 hours.

- ► Press the 'P' button.
- ► Press the '>' button several times until '4/5' is displayed.
- ► Press the 'Switch off after' button.
 - 'Switch off after'
- ► Press the '<' or '>' button to change the switch-off time.
- ► Press the 'Save' button.
 - 'Saved' appears briefly on the display.
 - '4/5'
- ► Press the 'L' button to exit programming mode.

Setting the water hardness

The harder the water is, the more frequently the JURA needs to be descaled. It is therefore important to set the water hardness accurately.

The water hardness was set when the machine was first used. You can change this setting at any time.

The total water hardness can be adjusted on a continuous scale between 1 °dH and 30 °dH.

- ► Press the 'P' button.
- ► Press the '>' button several times until '4/5' is displayed.
- ► Press the 'Water hardness' button.
 - 'Water hardness'
- Press the '<' or '>' button to change the setting for the water hardness.
- ► Press the 'Save' button.
- 'Saved' appears briefly on the display.
- ► Press the 'L' button to exit programming mode.

Unit for amount of water

Example: Proceed as follows to change the unit for the amount of water from 'ml' to 'oz'.

Inserting/changing the filter

Your WE6 no longer has to be descaled if you are using the CLEARYL Pro Smart filter cartridge.

- i Once the filter cartridge stops working (depending on the water hardness setting), the WE6 will prompt you to change the filter.
 - i CLEARYL Pro Smart filter cartridges are available from specialized dealers.

- Fill the water tank with fresh, cold water and reinsert the tank.

The machine automatically detects that you have just inserted/changed the filter cartridge.

Cleaning the machine

After 180 preparations or 80 switch-on rinses, the JURA will prompt you to clean it.

Cleaning the bean container

Coffee beans may be covered with a slight oil film which remains on the walls of the bean container. These traces may negatively affect the coffee result. For this reason clean the bean container from time to time.

Precondition: 'Fill bean container' is displayed.

- ► Switch the machine off with the On/Off button .
- ▶ Remove the aroma preservation cover.
- ► Clean the bean container with a soft, dry cloth.
- ► Fill the bean container with coffee beans and close the aroma preservation cover.

Descaling the water tank

Limescale deposits may form in the water tank. To ensure correct function of the machine, descale the water tank from time to time.

- ► Remove the water tank.
- ► If you use a CLEARYL Pro Smart filter cartridge, remove this.
- ► Completely fill the water tank and dissolve 3 JURA descaling tablets in it.
- Leave the water tank with the descaling solution for several hours (e.g. overnight).
- ► Empty the water tank and rinse it thoroughly.
- ► If you use a CLEARYL Pro Smart filter cartridge, insert this again.
- ► Fill the water tank with fresh, cold water and reinsert the tank
